There is not much known about this Baroque artist who came from Varese, Italy not too far from Milan. However, his work speaks for itself, this is a small devotional piece, probably intended for a private chapel. The diagonal composition lends to it a sense of the drama of the moment when Simeon, the faithful old servant of the Lord finally is blessed with seeing the long awaited Messiah with his own eyes. In the lower left hand side we can also see the silhouette of Anna, the prophetess, who is also an example of a person who lives their life in close proximity to God. In our western society today our elders are often ignored or even poorly treated. Here, in this story we are reminded that God sees all and knows all. And it is in how we treat all people, whatever their age, their background, their gender, their sexuality, their race, that we will be judged. Blessings, Mother Cherry
